CalSouth requires member clubs to put players on teams according to their birth date (not, for example, what grade they are in school). The cutoff is August 1, and the age category lasts until the next August 1. We are still in the 2009-2010 “Playing Year”, so people playing in the Spring League continue to follow the same age groups as they did in fall.

Examples: A player who was born on July 25, 2001 was considered “Under 9” last August 1, whereas a player who was born on August 5, 2001 was considered “Under 8”.

CalSouth publishes a new “Age Matrix” each year. Find the box corresponding to the year and month of the player’s birthday and the number in the box indicates what age the player is “Under”.
